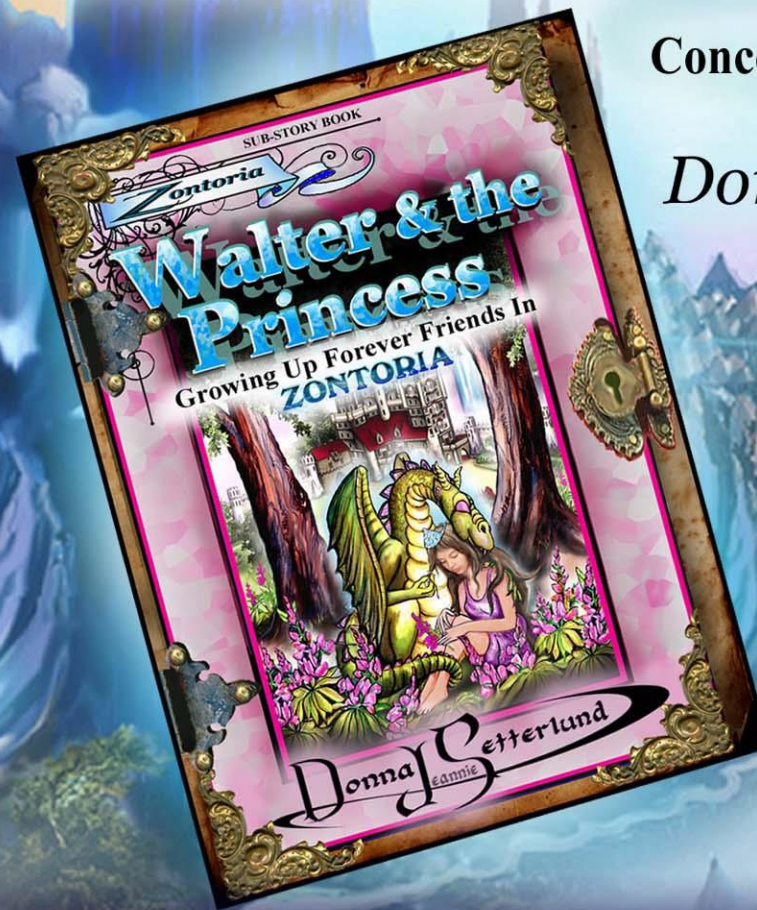

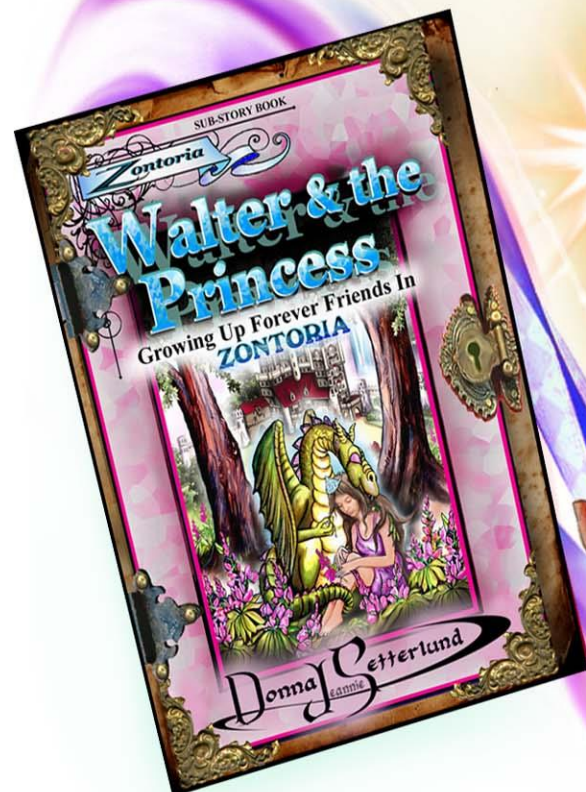

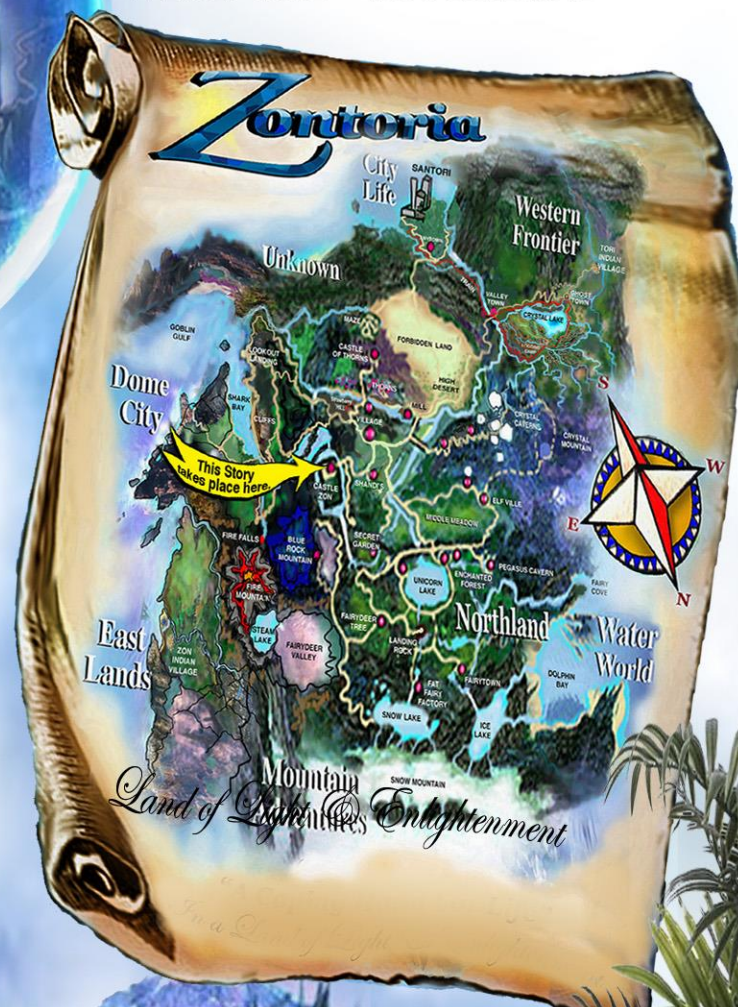

Zontoria ~ Coping with Life

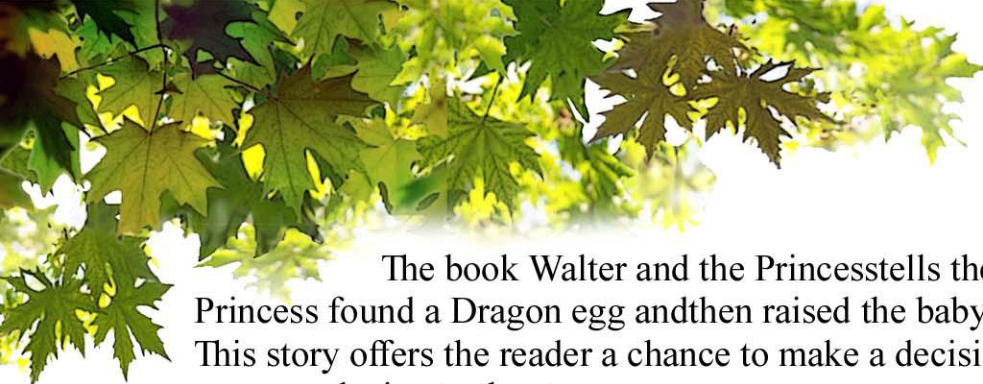

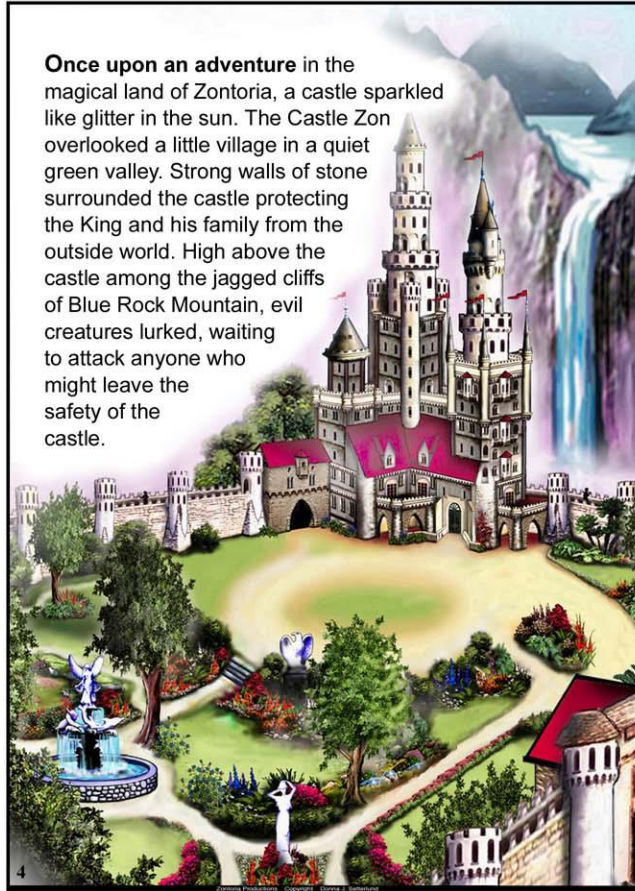

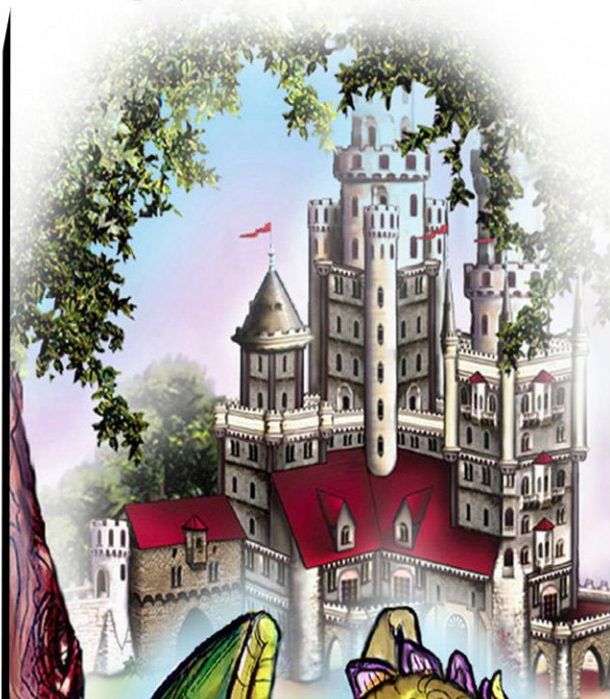
"I will call you Walter," she said as she pulled the last little bit of shell from his head.

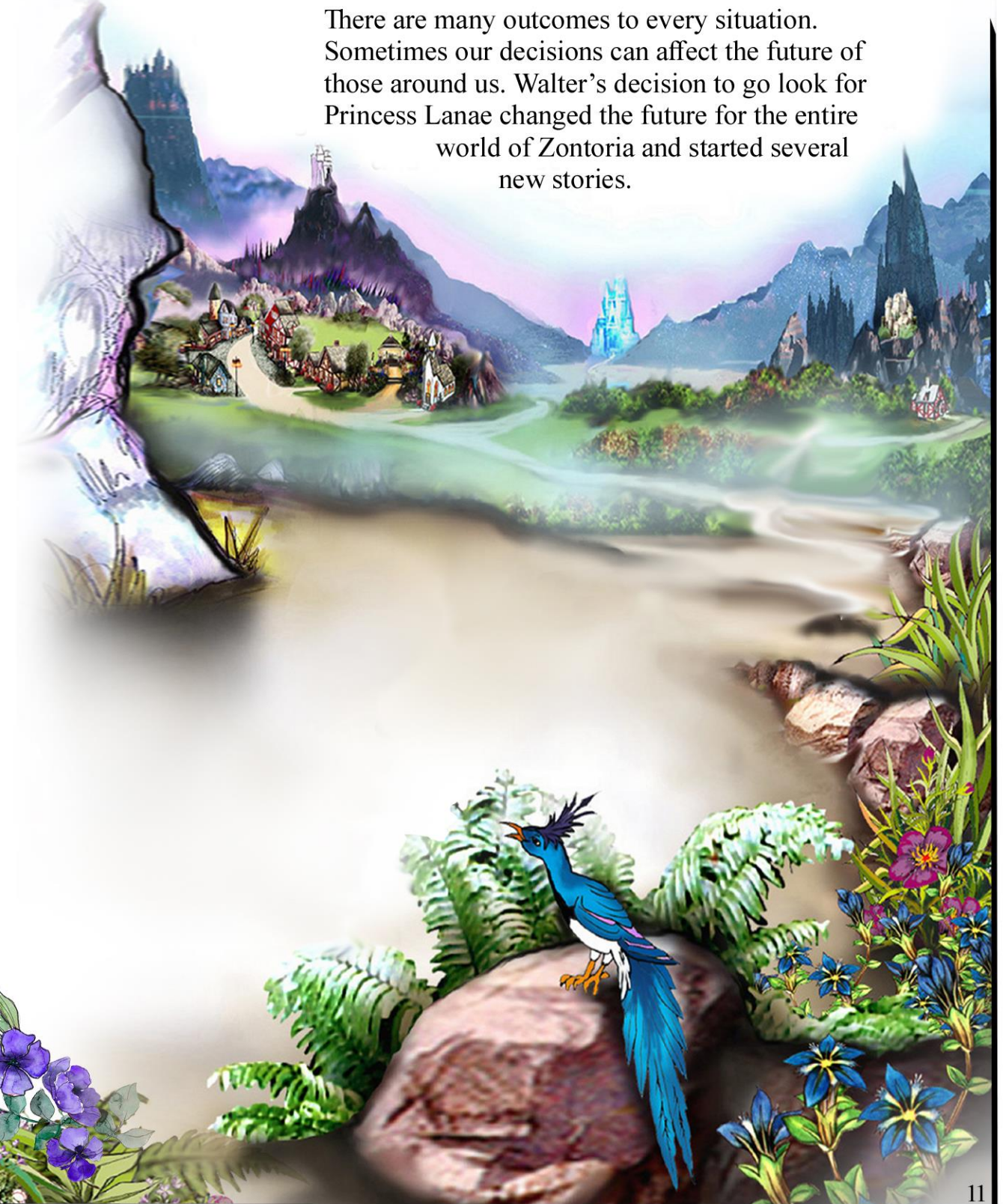
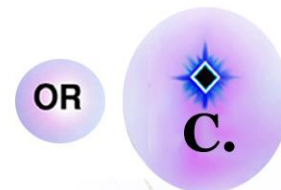

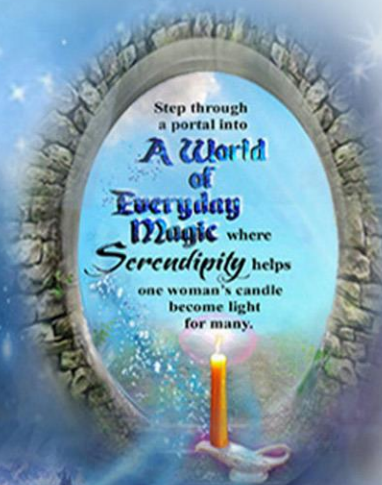
In the story, Walter must make a choice about helping find the missing Princess Lanae. After you read the book, maybe you could write your own story about Walter and how the book should end.
